

REQUIREMENTS TO CONNECT TO THE BLAIR TOWNSHIP WATER SYSTEM

- 1. A PERMIT TO CONNECT IS REQUIRED FROM BLAIR TOWNSHIP.
(CONTACT TOWNSHIP FOR PERMIT COST)**

- 2. A PLUMBING PERMIT IS FROM GRAND TRAVERSE COUNTY
CONSTRUCTION CODE OFFICE, LOCATED AT 2650 LAFRAINER RD.
ALL NEW SERVICE CONNECTIONS MUST BE INSPECTED BY A COUNTY
PLUMBING INSPECTOR BEFORE IT IS COVERED OR BURIED, NO
EXCEPTIONS. FAILURE TO OBTAIN THE PROPER INSPECTIONS MAY
REQUIRE THE SERVICE LINE TO UNCOVERED AND INSPECTED BEFORE
THE SERVICE IS TURNED ON.**

- 3. SERVICE LINES MUST BE BURIED 6 FEET BELOW FINAL GRADE.
ONLY TYPE “K” COPPER AND 1” IN SIZE OR LARGER IS ALLOWED.
ONLY FLAIR FITTINGS WILL BE ALLOWED UNDERGROUND.**

- 4. A FULL PORT BALL OR GATE VALVE SHALL BE PLACED ON EACH
SIDE OF THE WATER METER. (DRAWINGS AVAILABLE AT THE TOWNSHIP)**

- 5. THE TOWNSHIP WILL SUPPLY A METER HORN FOR METERS 1” IN
SIZE OR SMALLER.**

- 6. CALL MIS DIG AT LEAST 4 WORK DAYS BEFORE YOU DIG AT 1-800-
482-7171**

- 7. THE TOWNSHIP WILL MAKE A WITNESS REPORT (DRAWING) OF
THE SERVICE LINE BEFORE IT IS COVERED, CALL 276-0374 AT LEAST 24
HOURS BEFORE DIG AND LEAVE A MESSAGE.**

- 8. THE CURB STOP VALVE MAY BE OPENED BY THE INSTALLER FOR
THE PURPOSE OF COUNTY PLUMBING INSPECTION, THEN IT MUST BE
TURNED OFF AND ONLY REOPENED BY THE TOWNSHIP AT THE TIME
OF METER INSTALLATION. NO EXCEPTIONS!!!!!!!!!!**

- 9. THE TOWNSHIP WILL REQUIRE 24 HOURS NOTICE FOR ANY METER
INSTALLATIONS.**

**IT IS THE INSTALLERS RESPONSIBILITY TO OBTAIN ALL
